



OBJECTIVES

To provide pre-school education, learning support for both in-school and out of school children, mainstreaming of out-of-school children, computer literacy and vocational training for the youth. Spreading educational awareness in the community.



COMMUNITY LEARNING CENTERS

The prime objective of this Centre "Empowering community through learning". It is an organization, working for providing quality education to underprivileged children and providing vocational skills courses for youth. Community learning center program was initiated in April 2015 for providing enhancement learning classes underprivileged children of Jaipur. Serving 3500+ children since inception. In present Saraswati Sansthan running 5 Community Learning Centers (CLC) in Jaipur and covering around 570 children.



A record no of more than 3500 children are getting benefits from this program.



SAKSHAM

Saksham is being implemented with the vision of empowering women from urban & rural communities in Jaipur Rajasthan. With Saksham, Centum & Saraswati Sansthan aim to works towards reducing unemployment and poverty In India. The program aims at improving livelihood opportunities and enhancing income generation capabilities bν undertaking programs for skilling, enterprise development and employability enhancement.

Saksham trains youth and women in skills necessary for industries such as textiles & Apparel. Our enterprise development initiatives equip newly skilled workers with the tools necessary to transition into small business owners, increasing their income generation capacities. The program also reaches out to technical institutes for improving their work readiness. This makes our beneficiaries compatible and capable of keeping up with the latest employment requirements and trends. This is a project for women in the sector of Apparel for becoming Sewing Machine Operator/ Self-employed Tailor, so that they can earn some money & become self-dependent. The target group of the females were between 18-35 years. This year 122 were placed in different places and 66 were settled up their own venture.

SANJEEVANI

With RPGF we formulated Sanjeevani – to mobilize women and youth to be trained as professional health care workers and nurses. The program aims to skill developing youth and women with a dignified livelihood in the booming healthcare sector as patient care assistants & General Duty Assistant. In the first year, the project has been able to place out to 56 beneficiaries of the communities around different locations at Jaipur.

Along with the medical training, emphasis is also laid on the grooming, English literacy and personality development. The beneficiaries are provided with employment avenues through collaborations with homecare placement agencies, hospitals and nursing homes.
